INTRODUCTION TO SILKSCREENING

We are thrilled to present New York designer and silkscreen instructor, Edie Ure, for Intro to Silkscreening! This class will cover the preparation of artwork for printing, what makes strong design, and the basics of printing on various kinds of fabrics. An introduction to repeat design and registration will also be covered. Students should come to the first meeting with items and materials to print on, as well as artwork inspiration: tear sheets, sketches, photos, clipart or original drawings. Students will leave the print day with their own screen and the experience of printing their design on t-shirts, totebags, fabric yardage, and more. Class meets twice: one 2-hour lecture and one 6-hour print day. Class size very limited; sign up early! Fee includes instruction, screen, ink and proof printing material. Students can also bring or purchase t-shirts or other items on which to print. \$225
